Hexham Rotary Helps Tynedale Hospice

Tynedale Hospice at Home has received a £771 donation from Hexham Rotary following a street collection in Hexham in December.

The charity was one of three local causes to receive a share of the overall total of £2,313 collected between 18th and 21st of December in Fore Street.

Charlotte Pearson, Fundraising Manager, Tynedale Hospice at Home, said: "We are thrilled to be receiving this fabulous donation which will make a real difference to people who need our support. It costs around £800,000 a year to run our service and 90 per cent of this need to be raised through fundraising and voluntary giving. Every year demand for our services grows and donations like this will help us continue to meet this growing need. "This amount could pay for 26 hours of end of life nursing care to a patient in their own home which is fantastic. We are so grateful to Hexham Rotary for organising the collection and the public who donated so generously."

Tynedale Hospice at Home is a Northumberland-based charity providing end of life nursing care to people in their own home, Hospital Transport and pre and post bereavement support through its Family Support Services to people living in the areas of West Northumberland, Tynedale and Ponteland.

It serves a community of around 70,000 people across 800 square miles of rural Northumberland.
